General criteria for the criterion-referenced two-pointed grading scale

Pass (G)

In order to receive the grade G (Pass), the student must demonstrate sufficient results in relation to the requirements of all the learning objectives.

Fail (U)

Students who do not demonstrate sufficient results in relation to the requirements of all the learning objectives of the course will receive the grade U (Fail).

General criteria for the criterion-referenced three-pointed grading scale

Pass with distinction (VG)

In order to receive the grade VG (Pass with distinction), students must demonstrate very good results in relation to the requirements of the learning objectives.

Pass (G)

In order to receive the grade G (Pass), the student must demonstrate sufficient results in relation to the requirements of all the learning objectives.

Fail (U)

Students who do not demonstrate sufficient results in relation to the requirements of all the learning objectives of the course will receive the grade U (Fail).
