





How to Update


- Click on the Windows icon.
- Click on the gear icon (Settings)



- Select "Windows Update."
- Click on "Check for updates."



When the update "Windows 11, version 24H2" appears: Click "Install"




You can now close the Settings window. The update will run in the background and may take some time. During this process, you can continue to use your computer as usual.

Restart after Update

Once the background installation is complete, a notification will appear asking you to restart your computer to finish the update. If this notification disappears before you respond, you will notice an orange indicator on the Windows Update icon. This restart typically takes around one hour.

It is crucial that you allow the restart to complete fully – do not interrupt this process. Interrupting the restart process may cause your computer to become unusable



FAQ: Question about .gitkeep file

After updating Windows, you may see a prompt about what to do with a ".gitkeep" file. Press the ESC key or click "Clear" to dismiss this message. This prompt may reappear but will eventually stop. The message is unrelated to the Windows update itself and is triggered by another component that requires reinitialization after some time.
