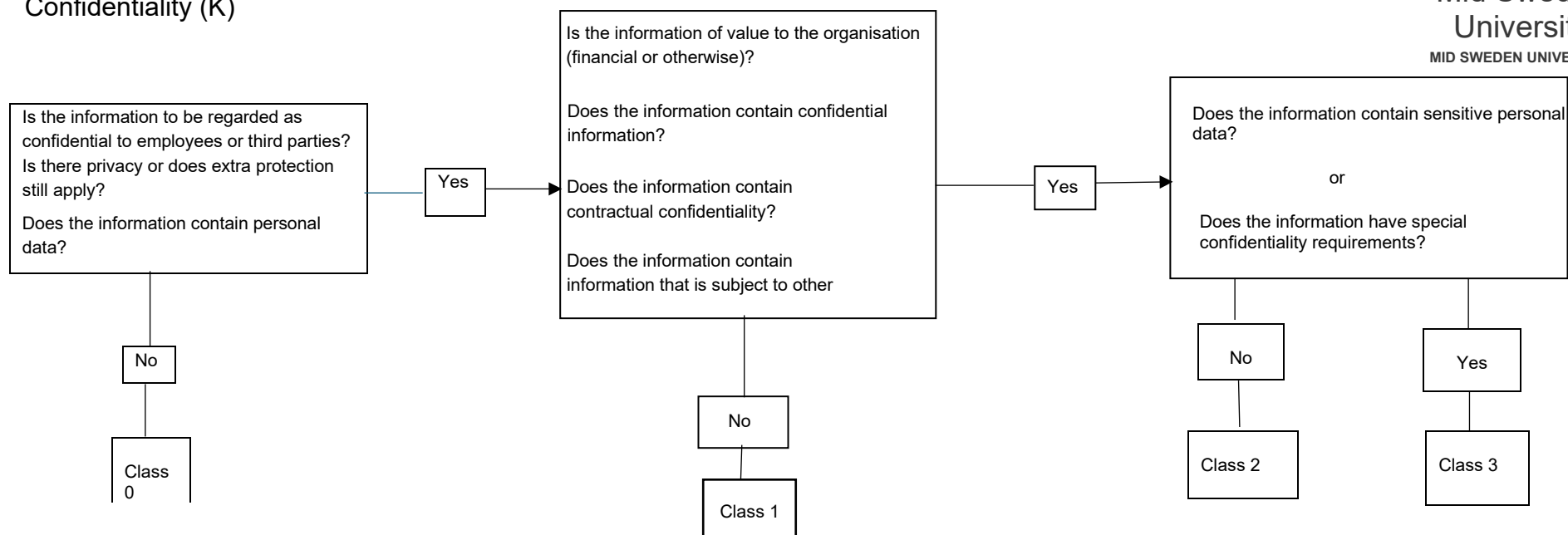




## Confidentiality (K)



### Examples of information

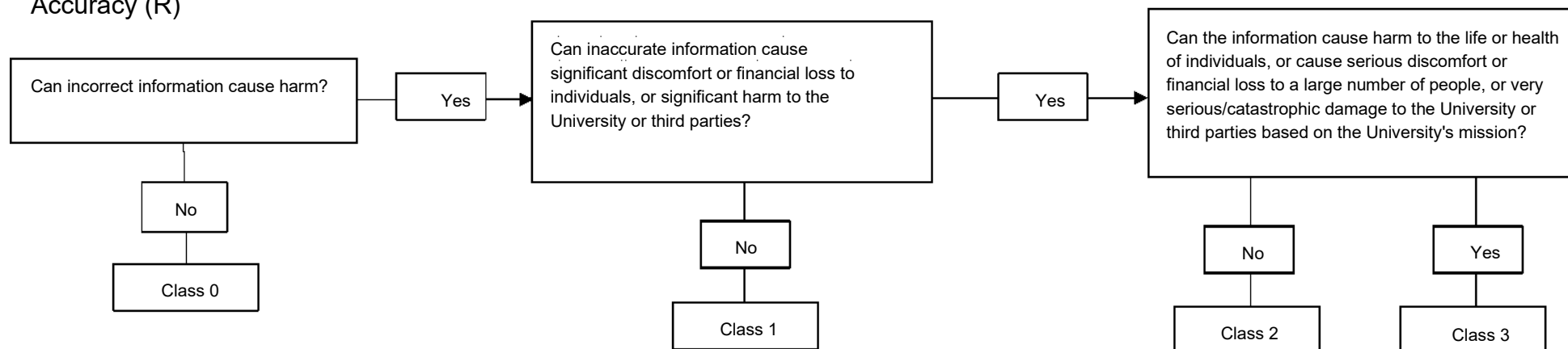
Class 0	Information presented publicly on the MIUN web, public document that does not contain confidential information
Class 1	Personal data (anything that can be linked to a person) that is not sensitive. Information that does not contain confidential information, contracts/agreements, working materials
Class 2	Information found in the financial system, logs, research data, procurements.
Class 3	Sensitive personal data or information linked to a person with a protected identity, passwords, crypto keys, firewall rules, particularly sensitive research data

### Possible Consequences of Shortages

Class 0	No consequences
Class 1	May cause discomfort or limited financial loss to individuals, or limited damage to the University or third parties
Class 2	May cause significant discomfort or financial loss to individuals, or significant harm to universities or third parties
Class 3	May cause harm to the life or health of individuals, or cause serious discomfort or financial loss to a large number of individuals, or very serious/catastrophic damage to the University or third parties



## Accuracy (R)



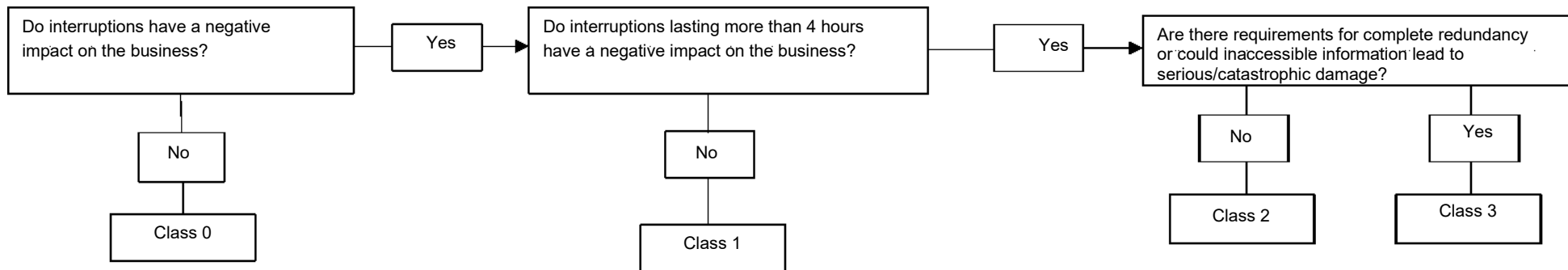
## Examples of information

Class 0	
Class 1	General information to external users, internal/external communication via e-mail, personnel matters, logs.
Class 2	Research material, articles, student assignments in undergraduate and postgraduate education, logs, procurements.
Class 3	Clinical/patient data, passwords, firewall rules, particularly sensitive research data.

## Possible Consequences of Shortages

Class 0	No consequences
Class 1	May cause discomfort or limited financial loss to individuals, or limited damage to the University or third parties
Class 2	May cause significant discomfort or financial loss to individuals, or significant harm to universities or third parties
Class 3	May cause harm to the life or health of individuals, or cause serious discomfort or financial loss to a large number of individuals, or very serious/catastrophic damage to the University or third parties

## Availability (T)



### Examples of information

Class 0	
Class 1	Personnel matters, financial data, payroll lists, logs
Class 2	Research materials, articles, student assignments undergraduate and postgraduate education, logs, procurements
Class 3	Systems that affect life and health

### Possible Consequences of Shortages

Class 0	No consequences
Class 1	May cause discomfort or limited financial loss to individuals, or limited damage to the University or third parties
Class 2	May cause significant discomfort or financial loss to individuals, or extensive harm to universities or third parties
Class 3	May cause damage to the life or health of individuals, or cause serious discomfort or financial loss to a large number of people, or very serious/catastrophic damage to the University or third parties, based on the University's mission.
